NEW JOB BY ERFA

ERFA, the European Rail Freight Association, will strengthen its representation by recruiting an additional employee (female/male) for its work in Brussels in favour of a fully liberalised rail freight market in Europe, in which all operators and railway undertakings can compete on a fair and transparent basis.

The successful candidate at the beginning will be mainly responsible for lobbying with specific national and European institutions on the legal and commercial content messages for ensuring that ERFA's messages are understood and taken into consideration during opinion building processes (appreciated) by the widest possible audience of decisions makers, both in Brussels and in the respective member states, as well as for supporting the Secretary General, the President on relevant ERFA activities. He/she will also take care of the production and update of different presentation and communication supports. He/she will report to the Secretary General.

The candidate will be based in Brussels, must be fluent in German and English. Knowledge of French is a plus. The candidate must have a good understanding of the German culture and business environment. He/she should have professional experience in both legal and economic issues and must demonstrate an ability both to listen and put across arguments in a charismatic and convincing manner, and preferably has experience in an institutional lobby background with good knowledge of the working of European institutions. He/she must be highly self-motivated, well organized with good analytical capabilities and excellent writing skills. A knowledge of the European rail system(s) would be an advantage.
